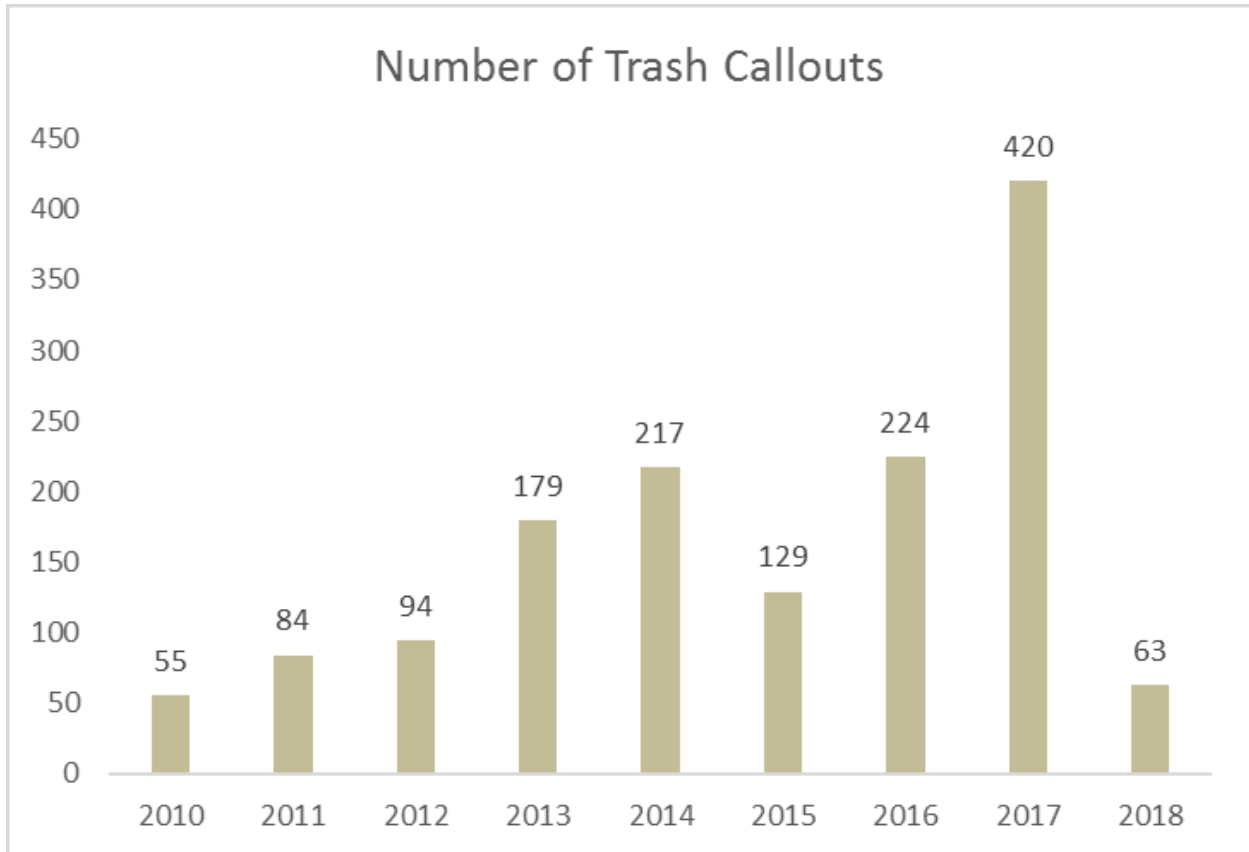


IVGID Solid Waste Update – February 22, 2019

In 2018, the Incline Village/Crystal Bay, NV community completed one full calendar year of Zero Tolerance enforcement for solid waste trash containment. Initiated in August 2017, Zero Tolerance Enforcement (ZTE) mandated strict field enforcement of the trash storage rules outlined in IVGID Solid Waste Ordinance 1.



The results of IVGID's concentrated and consistent enforcement effort for 2018, shows an 85% drop in violations (63 incidents) over the previous year (420 incidents). Waste Management's snapshot reports (photos taken on site of problems at service locations) and the amount of fines issued in 2018, have also shown dramatic reductions.

The chart below summarizes reported issues and fines issued, by calendar year.
