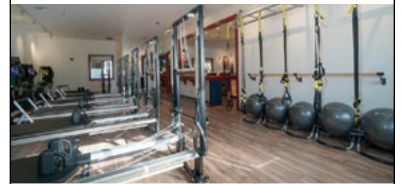

IVGID Accomplishments For 2017-18

IVGID's updated Strategic Plan was summarized in the last edition of the IVGID Quarterly. The narratives for the Plan's six Long Range Principles were included in the summary. Each Long Range Principle also includes specific objectives and budgeted initiatives for the upcoming fiscal year.

Each year, in conjunction with the General Manager's Performance review, a summary is compiled to ensure that the District is implementing the contemplated actions included in the Strategic Plan in a timely and effective manner. The summary is included below:

Summary of General Manager's Performance Objectives

- Ensure that the Strategic Plan is implemented in an effective and timely manner;
- Execute all the implementation actions outlined in the Strategic Plan;
- Monitor external factors and reassess elements of the Strategy, as necessary; and
- Focus appropriate energies on the elements of the Plan which require the highest level of direct involvement from the General Manager.
