

SEWER BACKUPS ARE:


- Gross • Unhealthy
- Costly • Harmful to our rivers and lakes

DID YOU KNOW?

- Most sewer spills are preventable and are the result of misuse of the sewer system
- Flushed baby wipes and other items cause tens of thousands of dollars in damage each year
- Flushing anything other than human waste and toilet paper down the toilet can damage household plumbing, the environment, and the wastewater system




CLOGGED PIPES...
EWWW!



OK TO FLUSH:

- Human Waste
- Toilet Paper





NOT OK TO FLUSH:

- Baby Wipes, including "flushable" wipes
- Paper Towels
- Cotton Swabs
- Tampon/Pads

NOT OK TO FLUSH:

- Condoms
- Tissue/Kleenex
- Dental Floss
- Diapers
- Cleaning Pads/Wipes

"FLUSHABLE" WIPES AREN'T FLUSHABLE!

Test after test proves that "flushable" wipes don't break down in the sewer.

UPGRADE A TOILET OR WASHING MACHINE; RECEIVE A \$100 REBATE

Applications for high efficiency appliances are open! There is one rebate eligible per parcel, up to \$100 credit towards their IVGID utility bill. High-efficiency appliances eligible for the rebate include WaterSense toilets using 1.28 gallons of water per flush, or Energy Star washing machines that have a water factor of 3.7 or less.
