Incline Village Public Works is proud to be able to offer to all Incline Village and Crystal Bay residents the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program, a service designed to protect our source water, sewer pump stations, and wastewater treatment plant. This program provides the community with an easily accessible method for disposing of HHW, ensuring environmental safety and community health. Our HHW and Electronic Waste (E-Waste) collection program, run by the IVGID Public Works – Waste Not program, plays a vital role in watershed protection.

By collecting and properly disposing of hazardous wastes and e-waste, we maintain the safety and quality of our drinking water. IVGID staff collects, sorts, and stores waste properly before coordinating with our hauler, Clean Earth, for monthly service. E-waste is collected and stored until removed by Intelligent Lifecycle Solutions for recycling.

ENSURING SAFE DISPOSAL PRACTICES

ACCEPTED HHW ITEMS AND LIMITATIONS

ACCEPTED HHW ITEMS:

Typical household chemicals are accepted: these include cleaners, poisons, aerosols, etc.

ACCEPTED E-WASTE ITEMS:

Computers, phones, wires, circuitry, printers, stereos, audio visual devices and other electronics that plug into a wall are accepted with some notable exclusions.

LIMITATIONS:

- Motor oil, car batteries, and antifreeze: Dispose of these at the Waste Management transfer station for a
- Ammunition, fireworks, and other explosives: Contact North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District for proper disposal information.
- Televisions and CRT monitors: Dispose of directly with Hero Environmental (775-900-4376) or Intelligent Lifecycle Solutions (775-690-9348).
- Countertop appliances (excluding microwaves): Not accepted by our E-waste hauler.
- Vacuum cleaners and beauty products: Not accepted due to health and cleanliness reasons.
